AmpEBR: Amputation Rehabilitation Evidence-based Review Update
Dalton L. Wolfe, PhD

AmpEBR is a systematic evidence-based review project examining the various practices associated with amputation rehabilitation. The objectives of this project are to:

1. Identify the priority areas in amputation rehabilitation for which strong evidence for effectiveness is lacking and therefore requires more research.
2. Identify those areas where the research evidence is strong and should be transferred rapidly and effectively to improve amputation programs and services.

This presentation will provide an overview of the project and give an update on project status. Some specific examples will be provided to illustrate the various topics that have been examined to date. These will be focused in the areas of outcome measurement and rehabilitation outcomes.
